FAQ: Enrichment e-Learning Day

When will District 210 use an Enrichment e-learning day? Lincoln-Way District 210 will implement Enrichment e-Learning Days starting Tuesday, March 17-March 27. Spring Break will still be held March 30-April 3.

How will students and parent be notified if an Enrichment e-Learning day will be used? Parents and students will be notified the same as they have been informed in the past of emergency related school closings. The announcement will be posted on the school website, www.lw210.org communicated via other social media outlets, as well as a phone call via School Messenger.

How will attendance be taken? Parents will receive an email each morning with a link to report their student's attendance and participation in the Enrichment e-Learning day.

When will Enrichment e-Learning day assignments be sent? Assignments will be communicated with students via email or Skyward. Consideration will be given to students needing additional time to complete assignments due to unforeseen circumstances.

What will it look like for students? Student work on these days should be independent. Flexibility will be provided for assignment due dates when appropriate.

What if we don't have Internet access at our home? Students will not be penalized if they do not have access to the internet, but they will be responsible for completing the work requiring the internet when they return to school.

How will the Enrichment e-Learning day impact after-school activities? ALL before and after school activities, meetings, events, competitions, practices, rehearsals, field trips, domestic travel, building rentals, and performances are cancelled. **This includes the use of our buildings by outside organizations.**

Do Enrichment e-Learning days need to be made up at the end of the school year? The state has determined that e-Learning days do not need to extend the school year.

What if I need to get belongings from school? Students may enter the building on Monday, March 16 between 8-noon if needed to pick up all essential items, books, and valuables. After this time, students and families will not have any access to the school until further notice.
