# Coronavirus (COVID-19) Update

- No confirmed cases of coronavirus (COVID-19) in the district.
- Beginning Monday, March 16, students are NOT in attendance.
- e-Learning will begin Tuesday, March 17.
- Spring Break is still scheduled for March 30-April 3.
- Buildings will be open 8:00 am – 12:00 pm on Monday, March 16, for students to retrieve books, etc.
- Athletics, activities, field trips, and student travel have been postponed/canceled until further notice.
- Outside groups/rentals have been canceled.

# e-Learning

- e-Learning does NOT substitute face-to-face learning.
- e-Learning cannot replicate labs, activities, or other interactive experiences.
- The main purpose of e-Learning is to provide continuity in learning while school is closed.
- Attendance will be monitored through completion of e-Learning activities.

# e-Learning continued

- Students will be provided e-Learning from March 17 through March 27 (a total of 9 days).
- E-Learning assignments will be posted:
  - All at once on Tuesday, March 17 by 9:00 am with daily reminders/correspondence.
- OR
  - Posted before 9:00 am on each day of e-Learning.
- Daily communication/correspondence with teachers will occur.
- Teachers will respond to student emails regarding the lessons/assignment between hours of 9 am and 2 pm on e-Learning days.
- Students that are unable to complete/participate in e-Learning need to contact their counselor or building administration.
