### LIONS CLUBS

From the charter of the first Lions Club, 100 years ago, Lions of all countries have made the care of individuals with special needs, especially the visually impaired, their mission. The training of teachers, caregivers, and those who dedicate their lives to improving the quality of life for those with special needs is an important part of these efforts.

### THE SCHOLARSHIPS

Each year, the Mokena Lions Club awards one \$1000 and one \$500 scholarships to high school seniors who intend to pursue a career in the teaching of, caring for, or improving the quality of life of individuals with special needs. If such a career appeals to you, you are invited to apply for one of these scholarships.

### REQUIREMENTS

The applicant must be a resident of District 159 and have declared a major that is related to the teaching of, caring for, or improving the quality of life for those with special needs. The scholarships will be awarded based upon the applicants declared area of study, their academic performance throughout their high school career, and their willingness to serve their community.

### APPLICATION

Complete the Mokena Lions Club Scholarship Application and submit it along with a one or two page letter to your counselor.

The letter should include the following:

- ❖ A summary of your grades and GPA while in high school
- ❖ The college or university you plan to attend as well as your declared major and how you see it improving the quality of life for individuals with special needs
- ❖ Future plans and goals, including why you have selected this area of study as a career
- ❖ And any service activities either through school or your community in which you have been involved.

The application **must** be returned to Mr. Gardner in PPS no later than March 10, 2021.
